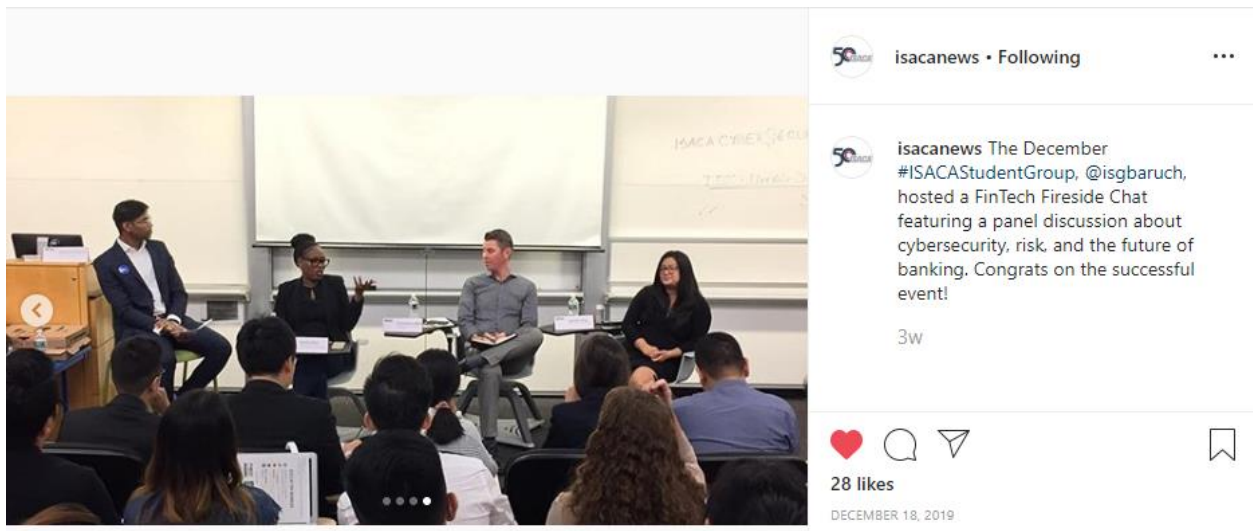
❖ Invitation to Discuss ISG Website Best Practices
